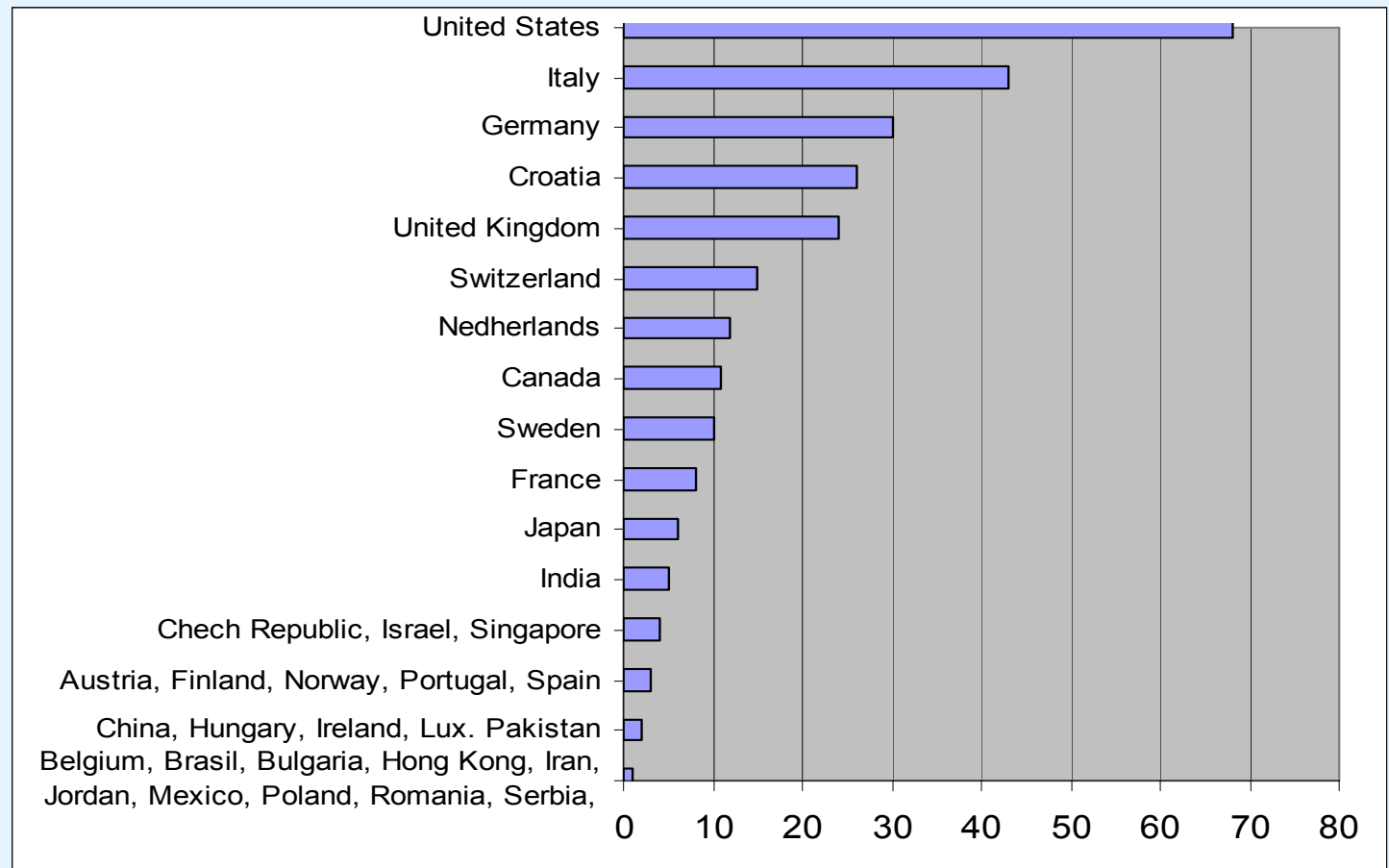

- **235** registered for the conference



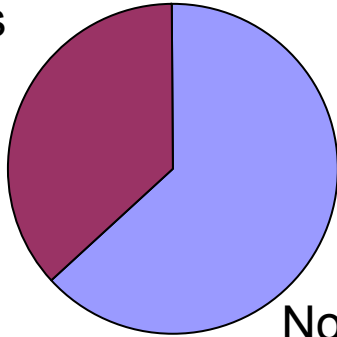

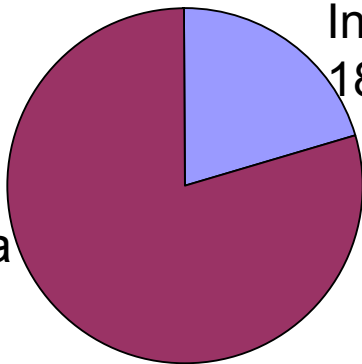

## The Technical Papers (parallel sessions)

- **42** (full) papers selected out of **251** submissions (record number) → **rate 16,7%**
- **18** additional papers accepted as **Posters**
- Two-phase reviewing process and a face-to-face two-days meeting in Minneapolis
- *Quite an effort* : A grandtotal of 645 reviews, making up to 25 papers for each PC member, plus more than 100 external reviewers
- 4 ACM distinguished paper awards: recipients announced on Friday morning



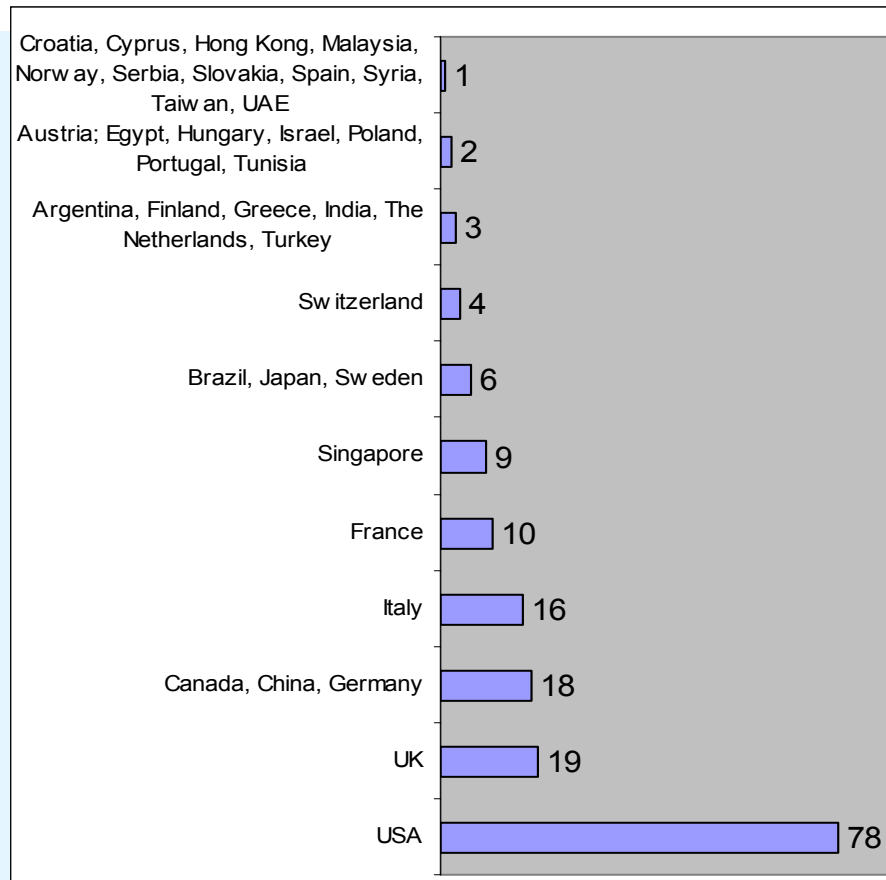

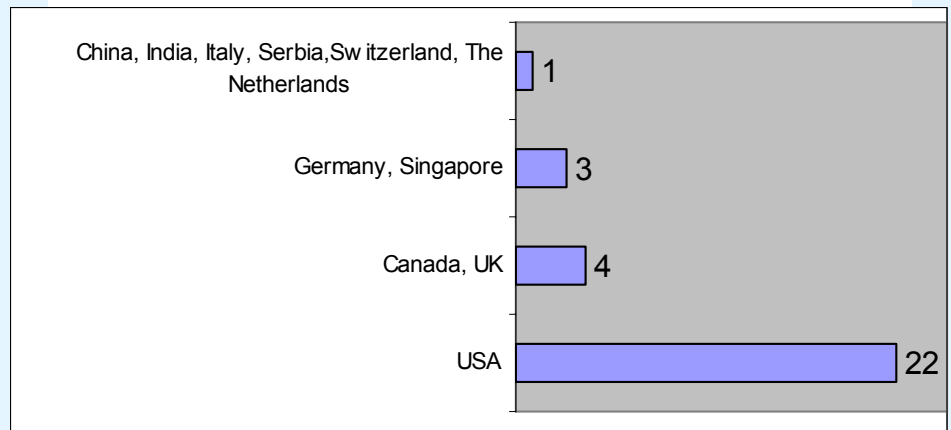
