

IS4SI is a biennial summit that gathers researchers from all over the world within information studies and related fields. It provides the meeting place for researchers from academia and industry, educators, societal stakeholders and others from a broad range of communities.

The IS4SI summits have their predecessors in conferences held in Beijing in 2010, and Moscow in 2013. The 2015 summit was hosted by Vienna University of Technology, while the next 2019 summit is planned at the University of California, Berkeley.

ABOUT THE TOPICS

Our global society becomes increasingly data-information-knowledge based. This is often called 'digitalization' or 'digital society'. What does digitalization mean for us as individuals, as societies and on a global scale, how does it affect our lives? Mobile devices, cloud computing, envisioned 'internet of things' and 'internet of everything' have already started to generate what is commonly called 'big data' and wealth of information.

Of course all this development is based on our fundamental knowledge of information, its dynamics (computation) and their connection to cognition. This summit aims to build connections between fundamental scientific questions and the most urgent human aspects of digitalization, seen from informational perspective.

A breakthrough to a global, sustainable information society must establish an information commons as a cornerstone of a new programme for coping with the challenges of the information age, based on shared understanding of information from its foundations to the values of its practical applications.
